Estynnwyd croeso cynnes i Arwel Price i wrando ar awgrymiadau'r Cyngor Cymuned ar gyfer gwelliannau posibl i oleuadau stryd er budd diogelwch y cyhoedd. Amlinellodd y Cyngorydd Shan Rees y cefndir i'r pryderon lleol a oedd yn gynyddol amlwg yn dilyn gwelliannau i lwybrau troed ar y gyffordd a'r defnydd cynyddol o'r gwasanaeth bws lleol.

Mewn ymateb derbyniodd Arwel rinweddau'r dadleuon ac roedd yn barod i gostio opsiynau i'w hystyried gan y cyngor cymuned mewn perthynas â'r canlynol:

1. Darparu colofn goleuo ychwanegol wedi'i gosod yn ôl o'r man croesi rhwng goleuadau stryd presennol 718-09 a 718-10 ger y gyffordd â'r A484 a
2. Colofn ychwanegol ar bwynt ger y lloches bws sydd wedi ei leoli ar yr A484 o flaen Tir Gof

Roedd Arwel yn obeithiol, ar ôl gwneud yr ymholiadau angenrheidiol gan gyflenwyr a chontractwyr, y gallid darparu costau cyn cyfarfod nesaf y Cyngor ar ddydd Iau 12fed Mai.

Manteisiodd cynrychiolwyr y Cyngor ar y cyfle i ofyn am ddiweddariad mewn perthynas â gwaith atgyweirio i'r golau panel solar diffygiol ger y lloches bws wrth y fynedfa i Gae Idole. Mewn ymateb cytunodd Arwel i fynd ar drywydd y mater hwn gyda'r bwriad o roi'r wybodaeth ddiweddaraf i'r Cyngor i ddatrys problem a oedd wedi parhau i fod yn rhagorol ers peth amser.

Notes of meeting on site near Tir Gof Llandyfaelog  
to discuss possible street lighting improvements on  
Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 10am

Arwel Price was extended a warm welcome to listen to the Community Council's suggestions for possible street lighting improvements in the interest of public safety. Councillor Shan Rees outlined the background to the local concerns which were increasingly apparent following footway improvements at the junction and the increased use of the local bus service.

Arwel in response accepted the merits of the arguments and was prepared to cost options for the consideration of the community council in respect of the following:

1. To provide an additional lighting column set back from the crossing point in between existing street lights 718-09 and 718 – 10 near the junction with the A484 and
2. An additional column at a point near the bus shelter located on the A484 in front of Tir Gof

Arwel was hopeful that after making the necessary enquiries of suppliers and contractors that costs could be provided in advance of Council's next meeting on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May.

Council representatives utilised the opportunity to seek an update relative to repairs to the faulty solar panel light near the bus shelter at the entrance to Cae Idole. In response Arwel agreed to pursue this issue with the intent to provide Council with an update to resolve a problem which had remained outstanding for some time.

Council's representatives thanked Arwel for his presence and looked forward to tangible progress with regard to the issues discussed.
